He worked as an electrical engineer for Westinghouse and Hewlett Packard before owning ServiceMaster of MidCarolina for 36 years. Jim had a wide variety of interests. He was a member of the Palmetto Mastersingers for 30 years and toured with them around the world to include the St. Lawrence riverway and China. Jim enjoyed sailing on Lake Murray, woodworking, playing the bass guitar and upright bass, and the ham radio.
